Caribbean Student Association Constitution

ARTICLE I

<u>Title</u>

Caribbean Student Association (CSA). The Caribbean Student Association is an organization of Wilkes University.

ARTICLE II

<u>Purpose</u>

- 1. Adding diversity to the Wilkes University student body and providing a cultural awareness and understanding to people of all nations.
- 2. Giving the Wilkes University student and faculty body an exposure to different Caribbean countries and their culture by organizing cultural events.
- 3. Partnering with other student associations from different schools that are similar to help promote this awareness.
- 4. Inviting speakers of Caribbean heritage to give key-note speeches about relevant societal and cultural problems.
- 5. Engage in charitable activities and coordinate fundraisers to promote a certain cause or world issue.
- 6. Encourage Wilkes student and faculty body to participate in trips to Caribbean countries for community and education services.

ARTICLE III

Membership

- CSA is open to all undergraduate students of Wilkes University, not depending on race, color, gender, or any type of discrimination.
- All members should participate in one event that CSA is promoting at that time and must be present for at least two consecutive meetings.

ARTICLE IV

Executive Board

• CSA's executive board will consist of four positions: President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer, and Public Relations Officer.

President

- Oversee all of the events and activities that the club is organizing

- Attend all SG President Committee meetings or send a member of the executive board to step in for the President
- Vote only when a tie happens during an election
- Oversee and attend all CSA meetings, in case an emergency occurs then it would reside to the Vice President

Vice President

- Assist in all event and activities that the club is organizing as directed by the President
- Report directly to the President
- Reside in the absence of the President

<u>Treasurer</u>

- Oversee all financial management, including being responsible for the budgetary expenditure
- Attend the financial workshop which is provided by the SG treasurer to access funds for the club
- Report directly to the President
- Also, to be in control of the finance when it comes to fundraisers that are organized by the club

<u>Secretary</u>

- Has a roster of all members
- Has an agenda for the executive board when the executive board has their meetings
- Has a record of all the minutes from each meeting
- Report directly to the President
- If the Public Relations Officer cannot be present, the secretary will take over that position

Public Relations Officer

- Works with the secretary in conjunction
- Aids the club in any type of assistance that it may need

ARTICLE V

Advisor

- The advisor of CSA must be a full time faculty or employee of Wilkes University. They must attend all meetings.

ARTICLE VI

Impeachment

- If majority of the vote (3/4), vote to impeach any member or advisor of the club, that will result in that member or advisor leaving their position.

ARTICLE VII

Elections

- Members of CSA can run only if they have attended at least two consecutive meetings.
- Each member who is voting must vote honestly and not condone to cheating
- Each election will be held the beginning of the spring semester The President will not run in any election unless they have successful achieved at least 4 semesters with the club

ARTICLE VIII

Resignations

- Any executive board member or officer who would like to resign from their position must give the board at least two weeks' notice in advance
